## Lakeside & Haverthwaite Trip - Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2025

Year 4 will be going on a school trip around the Lakes on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July. Children are to arrive at school on time for **8:45am** as the coach leaves promptly at 9am and will return to school at approximately **4:30pm**.

The children will begin by travelling to Windermere on a coach and visiting the World of Beatrix Potter. They will then board a steamer and have a boat ride across Windermere before arriving at Lakeside. Here they will visit The Lakes' Aquarium. Then they will board a steam train and travel to Haverthwaite Station. Where the final coach will collect them and bring them back to school for 4:30pm.

All children are to wear their school top and jumper, plain leggings or joggers, trainers and bring a waterproof jacket. They will also need a sunhat and sun cream. A refillable bottle of water is required for the day and children will need a packed lunch. *Those children who are eligible for free school meals will have a packed lunch provided, but will also need additional drinks and a snack.* Their packed lunch and water bottle should be within a small backpack which they will carry with them all day.

School is subsidising this trip therefore we are only asking for payment of £20 as a contribution towards the coach. Payment is to be made through ParentPay along with your consent for your child to attend, please can this be done by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> July.

If your child requires travel sickness medication please bring it to the school office the day before the trip and sign the consent form for staff to administer medicine.

Please also be aware that good behaviour in school is essential at all times to participate in school trips.
