HEAVES FARM TRIP – 25TH JUNE 2024

Year 3 & 4 will be going on a trip to Heaves Farm on **Tuesday 25th June**.

Children are to arrive at school for **8:45am** and will return to school at approximately **3:25pm**, if the coach is delayed we will contact you by text.

There will be demonstrations of traditional farming activities including sheep shearing, dry stone walling, milking etc with the aim of showing the children how food is produced – 'the story from Farm to Fork'.

All children are to wear their school top and jumper, with comfortable joggers or leggings, trainers and bring a waterproof jacket. If children have wellies please bring these too. If it is a hot day, pupils will require sun cream and a hat. All children must bring a packed lunch and drinks (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks). *If your child is eligible for free school meals, school will provide them with a packed lunch but please can you bring your own drinks.*

School is fully subsidising this trip for Year 3 & 4.

Please can you give consent for this trip on ParentPay and indicate whether your child will walk home or be collected upon our return. If you don't have access to ParentPay please contact school.

If your child requires travel sickness medication please bring it to the school office the day before the trip and sign the consent form for staff to administer medicine.

Please also be aware that good behaviour in school is essential at all times to participate in school trips.
